Stellenbosch Vineyards Therona 2016	14	17	16 R 200	Rich golden yellow with light green. Mineral, lime juice nose. Oily and very fragrant, big palate, full mouth feel. Good long finish with green apple. Tangy acid finish, flinty and mineral. From the farm	100% Therona, Stellenbosch. Hybrid of Cruchen Blanc and Chenin Blanc, unique to South Africa, developed at Stellenbosch University. Natural ferment, matured on the lees for 5 months in 2nd fill French oak. Only 265 bottles produced. Alc 13.5 RS 1.63 PH 3.28 TA 7.02
The Foundry Grenache Blank 2014	13	16	15 R 210	Darker golden green. Rich fruit, almond and peaches on the nose. Fresh entry becoming very creamy. Follows the palate, with marzipan. Nice balance of acid and minerality. Pleasant rich finish, quite citrus. Liquor City	100% Grenache Blanc, Voor Paardeberg. Whole bunch pressed, fermented on solids in tight grained hogsheads. Barrel aged for 8 months. Alc 13.4 RS 2.0 PH 3.35 TA 6.4
Stellenbosch Vineyards Verdelho 2016	13	17.5	16 R 250	Rich golden yellow green. Peach and orange blossom. Lovely full fruit entry, full mouth feel and strong presence. Lemon sherbet and orange marmalade. From the farm	100% Verdelho, Stellenbosch. Fermented in 60% 1st fill, 20% 2nd fill & 20% 3rd fill French oak barrels. 10 months maturation. Alc 13.86 RS 2.47 PH 3.33 TA 6.25
Ondine Grenache 2015	15	17	16 R 150	Clear light red brick. Perfumed nose with cherry. Lean entry then follows the nose with lots of cloves and Christmas cake spice. Austere tannins with a sweet and sour finish. Clean fruit, raspberry and black tea. Liquor City	100% Grenache, Darling. Alc 12.0 RS PH TA
Waterkloof serious cool Cinsault 2016	12	16	15 R 143	Pale cherry red. Light and fresh strawberry and cherry candy floss nose. Fruity and floral entry, red roses, light strawberry and pink musk sweets carries though. Nice light acid balance. Lovely spice finish for an easy drinking wine. Liquor City	100% Cinsault, Helderberg, 40 year old vines. Spontaneous ferment in wooden fermenters, punched down twice daily. Left on skins for at least 30 days. Malo in 2nd & 3rd fill French oak and matured for 11 months. Alc 12.2 RS 1.8 PH 3.75 TA 3.9
Stellenrust Cabernet Franc 2013	14	18	16 R 166	Dark garnet. Very dark fruit, with light spice nose. Dark cassis fruit entry, intense tannins and acid. Big stalky finish with hints of tobacco and cedar. From the farm	100% Cabernet Franc, Helderberg, Stellenbosch. Crushed, 1 day cold soak then fermented in open concrete tanks with daily punch downs for 7 days. Malo in stainless steel then matured in small French oak barrels for 18 months. Alc. 14.2 RS 2.1 PH 3.45 TA 6.0
Idiom Zinfandel 2014	14	18	16.5 R 215	Dark purple. Pepper and eucalyptus with rich red fruit nose. Lean entry, follows the nose. Full bodied with menthol, pine tar and honey. Liquor City	100% Zinfandel/Primitivo, Sir Lowry's Pass, Helderberg, Stellenbosch. 2 days cold maceration, ferment in stainless steel tanks with twice daily punch downs. Malo and maturation in 30% American oak and 70% French oak for 12 months. Alc 14.65 RS 2.8 PH 3.60 TA 6.30
